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General description

ANLA – A New Learning Arena is the project for development and improvement of adult educational system led by Piareersarfiit, Greenland with period of 2 years (2016 – 2018). This project has a strong partnership cooperation among different partners from Spain, Italy, Iceland, Denmark and Portugal.

Main objectives:

- Collect national experiences on adult learning, self-directed learning and cooperative learning strategies from 5 participating countries in order to share them on three consecutive partnership meetings with the aim of achieving a better understanding of the whole area;
- Identify common features and differences to such an extent that the knowledge can be translated into more general concepts, the partners produces and evaluates;
