Overview

The **NO GAP** project is being implemented from 2022 to 2024, by partners from Germany, Cyprus, Poland and Portugal.

The project aims to **support trainers in green professions** to teach new learning content to their trainees to sensitize them to the **consequences of climate change** and **future climate adaptation strategies**.

Partners will develop **new curricula** to enable trainers to add new skills and topics to their training activities. This way, trainees in sustainability-related sectors will **learn and develop skills to make green spaces, gardens and farmland fit for climate change**.

In addition, the project focuses on **creating barrier-free access** to these areas to promote diversity and inclusion in training, education and green jobs, and to **increase social inclusion for people with disabilities**.

- **12 learning videos** incorporated into a digital learning platform.





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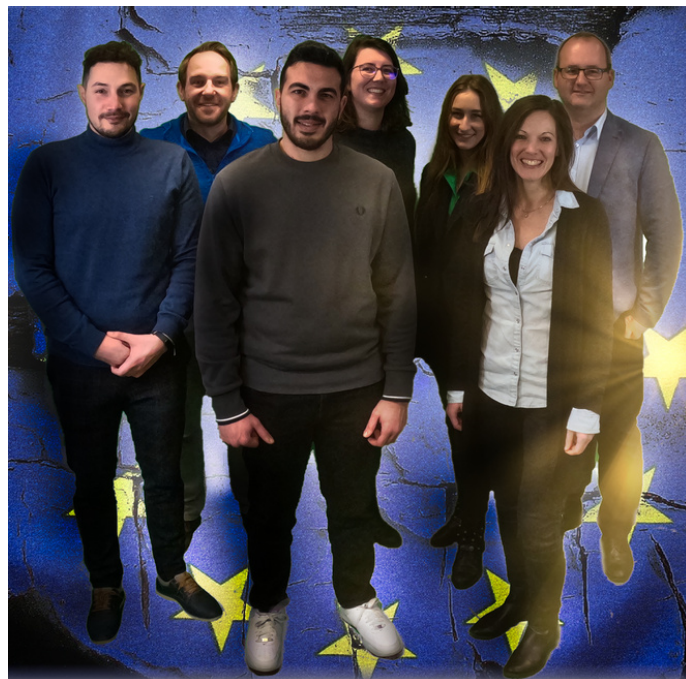
Kick-off Meeting in Giessen
