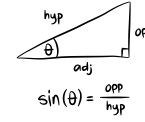

ROMANIA HOSTS THE 1ST TEACHERS MOBILITY

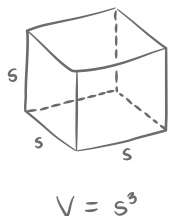
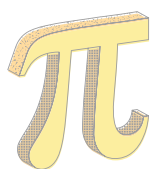
